

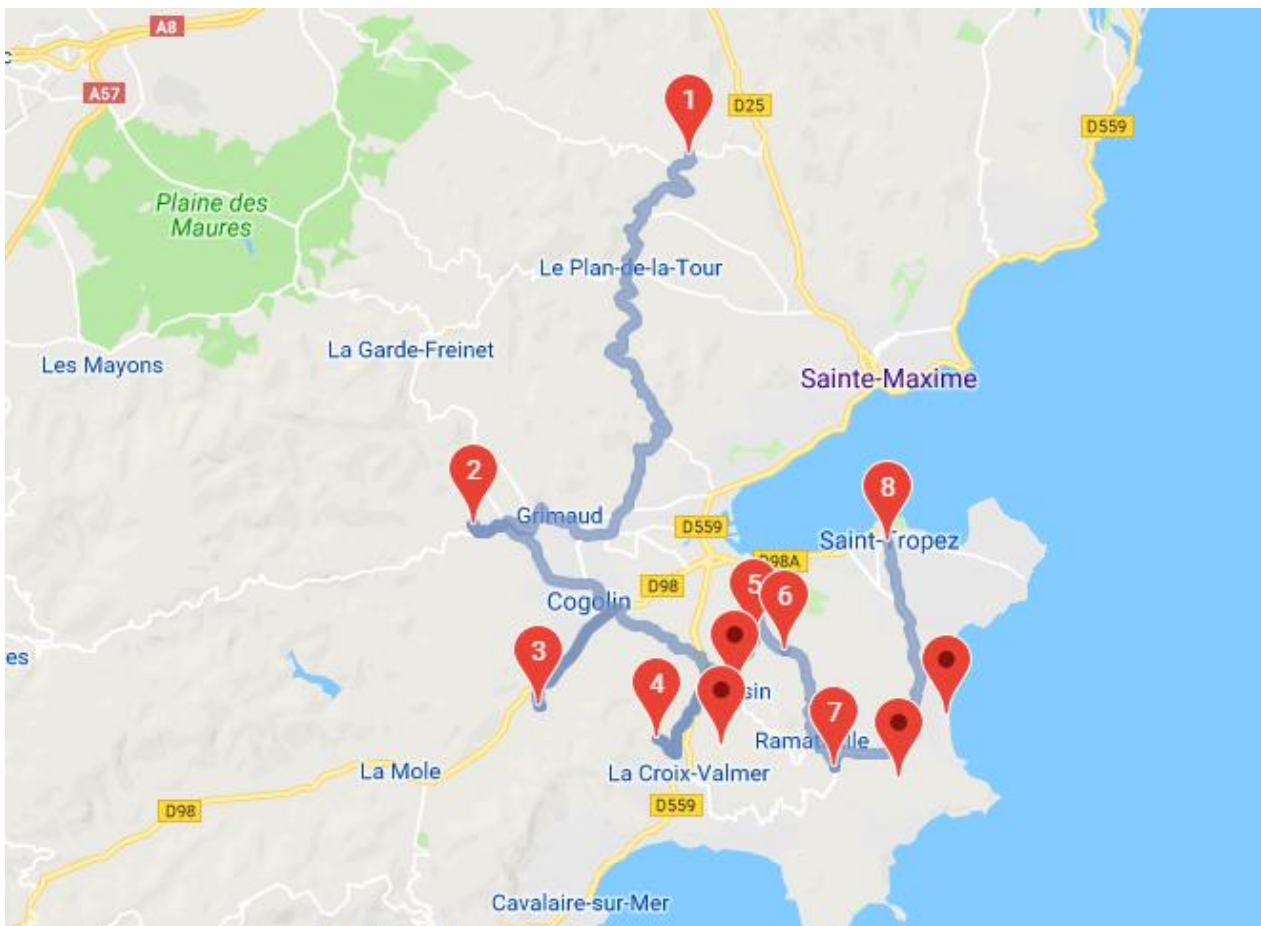
# WINE TRAIL
